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Standing Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Update State/Region</u>: The state hopes to be ready to accept applications for trauma, stroke, and STEMI designations starting in January 2016. They continue to work on the performance improvement process. They are developing a new logo and working to find site reviewers.</li> <li>• <u>EMS Update</u>: No updates.</li> <li>• <u>Coordination of Care</u>: No updates.</li> <li>• <u>Community Outreach/Prevention</u>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ February 4: AHA/ASA Heart and Stroke Workshop at St. Luke's Boise</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Secretary to send out flyer for AHA/ASA event.
Subcommittees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <u>Trauma</u>: The trauma committee met and they are working on developing tool kits for community education and prevention. Possible topics include: distracted driver, horseback riding. They also request that these tool kits be made available on the TSE website. There was also discussion of creating a calendar on the TSE website so that information could be easily shared.</li> <li>• <u>Stroke</u>: The stroke committee met and is working on a community awareness event in 2016. Nichole Whitener shared the educational postcard that is being developed. The group is also working on a regional map that would define each hospital's capabilities as it relates to stroke (tPA, CTA, etc.). Also discussion of having order set and tool kits available on the TSE website similar to the Montana Stroke Initiative.</li> <li>• <u>STEMI</u>: The STEMI committee met and is discussing metrics and the QI process. They were unable to find the TSE education for EMS. Dr. Nathan Green asked for clarification on the role the subcommittees will play in the QI process. The group discussed this issue, but no decision was made. Christian Surjan is working on a state-wide map of facilities that have cath labs.</li> </ul>	Christian to send EMS education to Secretary for distribution.

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	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Review of STEMI case from rural Oregon.</li> <li>○ Opportunities for improvement: pre-hospital information in medical record, improved follow up with EMS, earlier activation of cath lab crew</li> <li>○ Dr. Green recommended increasing the number of BLS crews that can do EKG's and developing a statewide process that improves STEMI activation.</li> <li>● Stroke (Nichole Whitener) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Approved therapies for stroke include IV tPA and mechanical thrombectomy</li> <li>○ Review of VA patient that was transported by EMS to a non-VA emergency department. He had CT/CTA done and received IV tPA. He was then transported to SARMC for mechanical thrombectomy.</li> <li>○ Opportunities for improvement: pre-hospital information in the medical record</li> </ul> </li> <li>● Trauma: Unable to review due to time constraints. Will review at our January meeting.</li> </ul>
