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Standing Items	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Update State/Region</u>: Monthly agenda is posted online. The council is currently reviewing the designation criteria for all levels of trauma, STEMI, and stroke. They are continuing discuss how performance improvement should be done in individual regions. • <u>EMS Update</u>: No updates. • <u>Coordination of Care</u>: Dr. Bedell requests that this committee look at transportation from rural areas when air transport is unavailable. Right now, Cascade must find a transporting agency for TSE events. Dr. Bedell is asking if the 911 service could be used to expedite these transfers. Dr. Morgan suggests that this issue be addressed at the state level. Dr. Bedell's email will be sent to Christian Surjan. Critical access hospitals do not always have ALS crews that can provide ground transport. • <u>Community Outreach/Prevention</u>: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ December 10: Dr. Porth will be providing stroke education to local EMS agencies in the Ontario, OR area ○ December 5: There will be community wellness checks offered at a bazaar in Murphy, ID. ○ December 15: Garden Valley is hosting a community CPR event 	Secretary to forward Dr. Bedell's email to Christian Surjan.
Subcommittees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Trauma</u>: No updates. • <u>Stroke</u>: The stroke committee is planning a stroke awareness event for 2016. Also, Teresa and Nichole met with Dr. Okon (Montana Stroke Initiative) and received some valuable information on improving stroke care in a rural state. • <u>STEMI</u>: No updates. 	
New Business	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>Quality Assurance Review Process/Manual</u>: Jana shared data from the Idaho Trauma Registry, including criteria for patients being entered into the registry. Data included: male vs female, age, severity score, ED LOS, mechanism of injury, mortality, and mortality by ISS. • It was suggested that the committee review trauma data quarterly and that QA measures for stroke and STEMI be shared quarterly, as well. Potential data points: door to drug, door to device, demographics, patient volume. • Image Trend is being trialed by the state at several hospitals for the purpose of collecting data on stroke/STEMI. • The goal of QA process is to be instructional and drive quality improvement. 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	<p>proposed that each month a different facility provides a case review of one trauma, one stroke, and one STEMI. Suggestion that reviewed cases include transfers. Goal is to make the process “discussion” based and not punitive. State website has a standard format for how cases can be reviewed. Jana will work on a schedule for when each hospital is assigned to present a case. Saint Al’s will present 3 cases for the December meeting.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Request by Louis Monson to improve feedback loop for EMS. He reports that he rarely gets feedback on transported patients. Concern that PCR form is not being used by receiving facilities.
