	<p>Southwest Region – Steve Blados Steve Blados shared the “code word” voted on for facilities to respond when receiving other critical patients will take effect on June 1st. The committee will be composing a list of the region’s EMS capabilities.</p> <p>South Central Region – Dr. Kevin Kraal Nothing to report for the South-Central Region.</p> <p>Southeast Region – Dennis Carlson Dennis Carlson shared the region will meet on Tuesday, May 16th to establish an EMS committee, and then meet on Thursday to review the earthquake tabletop. Nell J. Redfield Memorial Hospital (formerly known as Oneida County Hospital) submitted their Trauma Level IV application, and Bear Lake Memorial plans to apply by late summer.</p> <p>East Region – Dr. Brian O’Byrne Dr. Brian O’Byrne shared the next regional meeting is on Thursday, May 18th. A disaster plan will be discussed regarding the upcoming solar eclipse phenomenon.</p>
Trauma Case Review	Shelly McFarland presented trauma statistics relating to St. Luke’s Wood River, and a trauma case review regarding concerns in transporting trauma patients in bad weather conditions.
Trauma Triage Guidelines	The TSE Council came to a consensus on the revisions. The TSE Administration staff will update those and provide the new guidelines soon.
STEMI Case Review	Chris Shirazi and Louis Monson presented a STEMI case review from the perspectives of a rural EMS agency and healthcare facility when providing patient care.
Large Vessel Stroke	Dr. Ondrej Choutka discussed the importance of using an additional assessment to clearly identify a large vessel stroke patient. The TSE Council will vote on the best scoring system to implement state-wide. This will be an additional tool that will help once the FAST exam is positive and should assure that EMS will transport the patient to the most appropriate facility.
TSE Marketing	Christian Surjan shared the TSE Administration staff will reach out to the Department of Health & Welfare’s public information officer to help bring more awareness on TSE to the public, as well as the use of more social media.
Mid-level Provider	Christian Surjan explained the reason why RN’s and mid-level providers would need to ride in the back of an ambulance, yet causes potential legal issues. More meetings to come regarding this issue.

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Sepsis	Christian Surjan shared the next step to adding sepsis as a time sensitive emergency will require a change to the Idaho code of statue.
Stroke & STEMI Registry	Christian Surjan shared the purchase to upgrade the TSE Registry and add the Stroke & STEMI modules will occur in June with possible state wide roll out in January 2018.
