Regional Reports	<p>North Region – Chris Way Nothing to report for the North Region.</p> <p>North Central Region – Shelli Triplett Shelli Triplett shared St. Joseph RMC went live on July 1st with their trauma triage criteria. Two Trauma Level IV applications and one Trauma Level III application has been submitted.</p> <p>Southwest Region – Jana Perry Jana Perry shared at the last regional meeting, Dr. John Perl (St. Luke’s Boise) gave a lecture on the various stroke scoring system tools; and a trauma case review was presented sharing insight on the challenges EMS face in a rural area. Discussed utilizing the Stroke VAN(Vision, Aphasia, Neglect) assessment tool. The committee will discuss the preparations for the upcoming solar eclipse on July 21st.</p>

	<p>South Central Region – Dr. Kevin Kraal Dr. Kevin Kraal shared that he has resigned as Regional chair and Brandy Bartholomew has been elected to fill the vacant seat. The committee discussed a trauma case review involving a school bus crashing on a rural highway and the challenges of getting most of the region to participate.</p> <p>Southeast Region – Dennis Carlson Dennis Carlson shared an educational video about drunk driving has had a profound, positive effect on parents and students. The committee will not be discussing the solar eclipse since its pathway does not cross over the Southeast Region.</p> <p>East Region – Dr. Brian O’Byrne Nothing to report for the East Region.</p>
TSE System Update	Christian Surjan shared the TSE System is moving forwards in a good, steady pace. Here is an overview: 34 applications received since January 01, 2016; 21 designations approved to date; 13 applications are pending on-site surveys; and by the end of August, 20 hospitals will have some form of TSE designation – this half of the hospitals in Idaho.
TSE Education	This agenda item was omitted due to time and will be revisited in the future.
Sepsis	The TSE Council and the Sepsis Panel agreed more information needs to be gathered to better understand sepsis and its treatment to appropriately write the TSE rules and standards.
TSE Registry	Idaho Hospital Association (IHA) affiliates Stacey Carson and Chris Johnson presented the useful capabilities population-based registries can offer facilities when extracting trauma data.
Water Safety	Marisa Lunghofer, RN (St. Luke’s Boise) presented a Water Safety presentation which was created by the TSE Region 3 Trauma sub-committee, to help injury prevention in both adults and children. The presentation is available on the TSE website under the <i>Education Materials</i> tab.
Stroke Scale	Christian Surjan shared feedback regarding the scoring system has been positive so far. Discussions will continue for a couple more months before a recommendation is provided. Discussed the VAN and other stroke scales as a secondary assessment tool.
TSE Council	Christian Surjan shared Brandy Bartholomew, RN is the new South-Central Region’s chairperson. Possible candidates are still being considered to fill the TSE Council Vice-Chair seat formally held by Dr. Marshall Priest.
